<p><i>This item is inserted on the surface of the altar, and is made of stone or marble. It is marked with five crosses, representing the five wounds of Jesus</i></p>	<p><i>This pure white cover is marked with a single red cross. It must be blessed before it can be used at Mass, where it lays on the altar to hold and protect the body and blood of Jesus.</i></p>	
<p><i>This item is the first Layer that dresses the altar and covers the altar stone.</i></p>	<p><i>This little plate holds The bread that becomes the Body of Christ. It is always placed on the corporal.</i></p>	
<p><i>These two items remind us that Christ our light is truly present on the altar at Mass in the substance of his body and blood.</i></p>	<p><i>This cup holds the wine that becomes the Blood of Christ. It is always placed on the corporal.</i></p>	
<p><i>This item is usually located on the back wall of the church or sometimes is placed in the centre of the altar between the candles. It reminds us that Jesus death is the sacrifice of every Mass that is offered.</i></p>	<p><i>This white linen cloth is used to clean and purify the chalice, after the blood of Christ has been consumed.</i></p>	<p><i>This item of is a burial cover and is used to protect the chalice that holds the Blood of Christ. It must be blessed before it can be used at Mass and its only mark is a single red cross in the centre.</i></p>

<p><i>These two little Containers are used to hold water and wine.</i></p>	<p><i>This item is used by the priest to dry his hands after he washes them during Mass.</i></p>	
<p><i>This item extinguishes the candle flames and must be set down on the small plate after use.</i></p>		
<p><i>This item makes a special sound that calls us to attention during the most important moments of the Mass.</i></p>		
<p><i>This item is used to hold water for the priest to wash his hands during Mass.</i></p>
